

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

As we move into the red traffic light setting tomorrow (Monday) this creates limitations for our gatherings at Mass. We will see how this goes over the next few weeks and everything will be reviewed regularly.

Under the red traffic light system, we are allowed gatherings as follows:
25 people with no proof of vaccination and 100 for those with the Vaccine Pass.

Weekday Masses at St Columba's

No proof of vaccination is required, limited to 25 people.

Sunday Masses

The 7.00 pm Vigil Mass at St Columba's will be prioritised for those who are not vaccinated and no booking-in is required.

The 8.00 am and 10.00 am Sunday Masses will be for those with a Vaccine Pass and booking-in is required. If you need assistance to book in, please do not hesitate to contact me by phone or email.
