Our plan if someone who attended Mass tests positive for Covid.

Everyone who attended the Mass would need to self-isolate and be tested for Covid. If I am unable to say Mass, there may be a liturgy of the word and Holy Communion or more likely the Mass would be cancelled, and everyone would be notified by email or by phone.

Booking-in for Sunday Mass and the predicament we face.

Under the Red Traffic Light System, the maximum who can gather with proof of vaccine is 100 and last weekend, the 8.00 am and 10.00 am Masses were fully booked out. An extra 30 Parishioners who have not booked in, attended the 10.00 am mass. Some who had booked-in did not turn up, so their seats were given away.

Those who are unable to book-in may attend Mass either by staying outside or in the foyer of the church and Holy Communion will be brought to you.

If you have booked-in for Mass and are unable to attend, please cancel your booking or let me know.

Also, it is helpful to attend Mass on time. Don't be late!

A big thank you to those who are managing the door to make sure we are doing everything right. We do need more people to do this. Please, email me if you can help.
