Acts 2:1-11 1 Corinthians 12:3-7. 12-13 John 20:19-23

The gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost is the culmination of the death and resurrection of Jesus. The Spirit's task is to lead us more deeply into the mystery of Jesus, so that as disciples, we can bear witness to what we have experienced.
