The Catholic Diocese of Hamilton rejoices in the announcement of a new Bishop.

The Holy Father has appointed the Reverend Richard Philip James Laurenson, of the clergy of Hamilton, until now parish priest of the All Saints by the Sea parish in Papamoa and diocesan chancellor, as bishop of the diocese of Hamilton, New Zealand.

The Anglican and Catholic Bishops of Aotearoa New Zealand have issued a statement jointly expressing their horror at the latest acts of violence in the Holy Land and joining international voices in calling for an immediate ceasefire. Their joint statement is online here.
