THE ADVENT WREATH

The Advent wreath is made of evergreen boughs formed in a circle, which has no beginning or end. This reminds us of our God, who is eternal. The candles-three purple and one pink-represent *light*: Jesus, the Light of the world, who shines in our darkness, and shows us the way to the Father. Purple is the symbol of penance. The pink candle is lit on the third Sunday of Advent as a foretaste of the coming joy of Christmas. Our Advent prayer, acts of kindness and self-denial help make our hearts ready to welcome Jesus our Lord, as he comes to us on Christmas Day.
